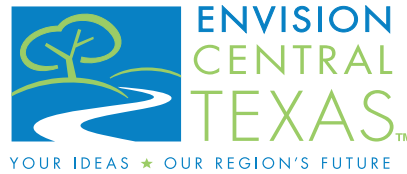


Keynote Speaker Shelley Poticha

Shelley Poticha is the Senior Advisor for Sustainable Housing and Communities at the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). She leads the recently formed federal **Interagency Partnership for Sustainable Communities** involving the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Department of Transportation (DOT), and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This group was created on June 16, 2009, to help improve access to affordable housing, more transportation options, and lower transportation costs while protecting the environment in communities nationwide.

Poticha has also been a co-chair at **Transportation for America** since its launch in 2008, president and CEO of the national nonprofit **Reconnecting America** since 2004, and former executive director of the **Congress for the New Urbanism**. Throughout her career, Poticha has become a national leader for the reform of land use and transportation planning and policy and has helped stimulate a national conversation about the role of transportation in shaping communities and making them more sustainable and affordable.

Shelley has co-authored several books, including *The New Transit Town: Best Practices in Transit-Oriented Development*, *Street Smart: Streetcars and Cities in the 21st Century*, and *The Next American Metropolis*.
